Main Street Fall Festival

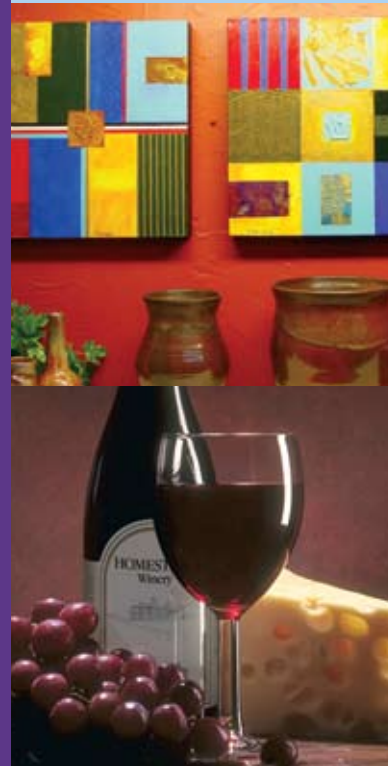
